## Term 1

Welcome to our class newsletter.

Have a read through all of the exciting things we have planned for the coming term!

#### Literacy & English

This term we will be focussing on the genre of 'description'. We will be learning about the structure of a descriptive text and how to write our own interesting descriptions.

In reading, alongside descriptive texts, we will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of reciprocal reading strategies to help strengthen our understanding. The strategies we will focus on are: prediction, clarifying, questioning and summarising.

#### Numeracy & Maths

In numeracy this term we will be building upon our prior learning of addition and subtraction and will further develop strategies through Number Talks and Rich Tasks.

In maths, we will be exploring patterns involving shapes, patterns, symbols and numbers. We will also be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and objects and will learn about their composition and properties.

#### Interdisciplinary Learning

We begin term 1 by taking part in the annual Levenseat Awards. We will explore power sources and develop our understanding of natural and fossil fuels. Using this learning, we will be tasked with designing a vehicle that is powered in an environmentally-friendly way and will construct 3D models of our vehicles.

Some learners in P3/2 will participate in a project presentation to the Levenseat judges in October.

#### Health & Wellbeing

We have already looked at Children's Rights and the UNCRC. Lots of discussion has taken place, ideas have been shared and a Class Charter created

The importance of positive relationships will continue to be explored and learners will be asked to identify their trusted adults within school.

In PE we will be developing a range of multisport skills, including the game of Benchball.
