Literacy & English

This term P6/5 will be looking at:

- · Reciprocal reading skills prediction, summarising, questioning and clarifying
- \cdot Consolidating previous spelling patterns and introducing new patterns
- · Meeting our writing targets through daily writing sessions using Writing Stamina

Numeracy & Maths

This term P6/5 will be learning about:

Time – Time intervals, converting between 12 and 24hour, read calendars and calculate length of time.

Data analysis – use varied formats to gather and present date, use spreadsheets.

Number and number processes – place value, estimating and rounding

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term P6/5 will continue to develop their French skills with Miss Ross. The children will be focussing on greetings, classroom language and numbers to 80 in French.

In RME we will be looking at various saints around the world.

In IDL the children are exploring the earth's layers, rocks and minerals, also the importance of saving energy
