Welcome to our class newsletter.

Have a read through all of the exciting things we have planned for the coming term!

<u>Literacy & English</u>

In Reading, we are working on reading with fluency then summarising the text we have read. We are also looking at how different punctuation marks are used and discussing the characters, setting and theme of the text.

In Writing, we are working on our Core Writing Targets for Description and Narrative pieces. We are trying to use descriptive words for characters and settings and trying to make our writing flow. In Listening and Talking we are working on taking part in group discussions and sharing our own work with the class with a steady pace and tone.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We have been learning about the benefits and drawbacks of different types of renewable energy. We used our knowledge to design a school that harnesses renewable energy and will turn this into a 3D model to enter into the annual Levenseat competition.

Our next topic will be based on Science learning about substances. We will learn key vocabulary, conduct several experiments to investigate changing states of different substances and learn how to write a scientific report.

<u>Numeracy & Maths</u>

Our focus in Numeracy is Place Value, Rounding and Addition and Subtraction. We have been learning through games, problem solving challenges and written work. Our number talks focus will be on fractions.

In Maths, we have been working on money, looking at profit and loss, budgeting, different ways to pay and calculations using money. We will soon start learning about 2D shapes, focussing on learning how to discuss their properties.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u>

We have been learning about the UNCRC and used our knowledge of rights to create our class charter. We have also been looking at the SHANARRI indicators and our school values. Finally, we will think about friendships, supporting others and building our resilience in different situations.

In P.E. we are focussing on team games. Mrs Simpson is teaching basketball and Miss Ross is teaching Netball.
